- **DMV Closures** - All DMV offices and mobile units are closed while essential services remain available online. **Anyone who cannot renew online is automatically granted a 60-day extension.**



- **Stimulus Checks** - If you have not received your check yet please call the IRS at 1-800-829-1040. They are available from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Monday thru Friday. **The best time to call is early in the morning.** The first question the automated system will ask you is to choose your language. **Once you've set your language, do NOT choose Option 1 (regarding refund info).**
