Wear a face covering and keep 6 feet apart from others in public spaces.

Wash hands before and after wearing a mask



Fit coverings snugly but comfortably against the side of the face



Use the ties or loops to put your mask on and off



Face coverings should have multiple layers



Avoid touching the front of the face covering, especially when you take it off

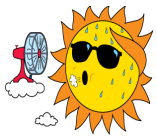


Wash and dry your cloth mask daily

Cooling Assistance Program



APPLY TODAY!

The State Cooling Assistance Program began on 6/15/2020; applications can be submitted via telephone by calling the customer service center at 855-635-4370, at www.commonhelp.virginia.gov, or by paper application picked up at the DFS office.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must have cooling expense responsibility
- Household must include one vulnerable individual age 60 or older, disabled or under age six.
- Household income must not exceed certain limits.
