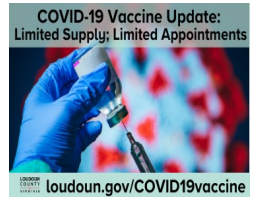
### Virginia's Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) released emergency allotments of benefits to eligible households in January.



Benefits were automatically loaded to recipients' Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT) cards on Saturday, January 16. The emergency allotments raise existing SNAP households' monthly allotment to the maximum allowable based on household size as follows:

Household Size	48 States and DC
1	\$204
2	\$374
3	\$535
4	\$680
5	\$807
6	\$969
7	\$1,071
8	\$1,224
Each additional person	\$153


**COVID Vaccine: Residents aged 65 or older can now sign up for COVID 19 vaccines. If you live in Loudoun County, call 703-737-8300 between 9:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. The hotline is open seven days a week, so if you don't get through the first time, call back again. If you live in Fauquier County, call 540-308-6072 between 9:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. Monday through Friday. The hotline is open seven days a week, so if you don't get through the first time, leave a message and they will call you back.**
