#### **Monthly Updates**



Virginia's Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) released emergency allotments of benefits to eligible households in January. Benefits were

automatically loaded to recipients' Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT) cards on Saturday, January 16. The emergency allotments raise existing SNAP households' monthly allotment to the maximum allowable based on household size as follows:

Household Size	48 States and DC
1	\$204
2	\$374
3	\$535
4	\$680
5	\$807
6	\$969
7	\$1,071
8	\$1,224
Each additional person	\$153
